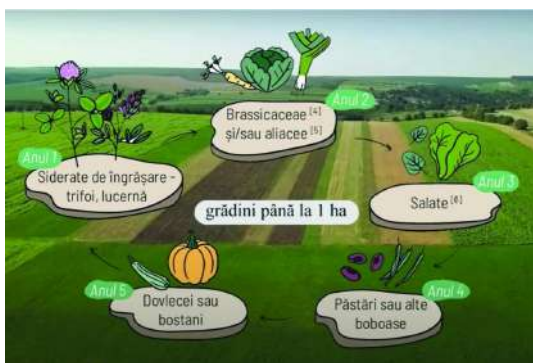
Seminar for farmers in Bălți
